2024/25 SEASON

STUDENT SEASON PASS \$229

For ages 6 to 22.

The off-peak student season pass is valid Mondays to Fridays anytime, and weekends/holidays after 4pm.

Holidays include December 26th-January 1st, January 20th, February 17th.

ADULT OFF-PEAK SEASON PASS \$519

For ages 23 +

The off-peak adult season pass is valid Mondays to Fridays anytime, and weekends/holidays after 4pm.

Holidays include December 26th-January 1st, January 20th, February 17th.

ALL-ACCESS SEASON PASS \$699

For ages 6+ Valid everyday all season long.

ADD-ON DAILY PICK-UP RENTALS \$109

All rentals must be picked up and returned the same day of use. When arriving as a group, a chaperone must accompany students to the rental area and ensure equipment is returned at the end of the evening.

ADD-ON LESSONS

1 Lesson \$29, 5 Lessons \$119

HOW BLUE'S PROGRAM WORKS

- Our sales team will set up your school's online portal. Your group leader will inform you when the portal is ready and provide a link and password.
- If you are a returning customer you may log in.
- If you are new to our program, you may register and add your children to our system as associates.
- Please upload a portrait photo for each associate.
- Once this is complete you will select your products and make payment.
- The group portal will close on November 3rd, 2024.
- Your group leader is your primary contact for questions.
- Season passes are only valid for the person issued and should not be shared.
- Our property is cashless. We recommend buying "Carver Cash" gift cards to simplify your child's experience at the resort. We offer a 10% match.
- Pro-rated credits may be issued as stored value or a Blue Mountain gift card only for injuries during the program. A doctor's note is required.

KNOW THE CODE

“Your Responsibility Code” is a set of safety guidelines for skiers/boarders, endorsed by the National Ski Areas Association, which all skiers and riders are expected to adhere to while at Blue Mountain.

- Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid people or objects.
- People ahead or downhill of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
- Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
- Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
- You must prevent runaway equipment.
- Read and obey all signs, warnings, and hazard markings.
- Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- You must know how and be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
- Do not use lifts or terrain when impaired by alcohol or drugs.
- If you are involved in a collision or incident, share your contact information with each other and a ski area employee.
