Hi Warwick Bears!

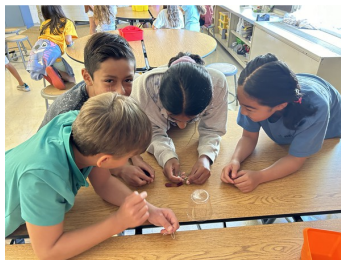
