Halloween Happenings...

Here's what's happening at Warwick this Halloween.

- We will have a school-wide Halloween parade on Thursday, October 31st. The parade will begin @ 9:45AM, and students/staff will parade through the Main Parking Lot. Should there be inclement weather, the parade will be indoors for staff/students only.
- Visitors should park in St. Cyril's Parking Lot which is located across the street from Warwick.
- Parties will take place after the parade. Designated parent volunteers should check-in at the office before heading to the classroom party.
- Reminder: This is an early dismissal day. **Students will be dismissed at 12:25PM.**

Guidelines for costumes:

- If your child can wear his/her costume to school, that is preferable since the parade begins at 9:45am. Otherwise, costumes should be brought to school in a bag labeled with your child's name.
- We discourage costumes that promote evil and/or violence (**weapons used as costume props are not permitted**).
- We discourage use of face paint and hair dye (these tend to get very messy).
- We love when parents come to the parade in costume; however, we ask that parents not wear masks that disguise their identity.
