Issue: How should power be balanced among the states in the central government?

m Side}\ 1$ : Equal representation in Congress for each state to protect the rights of small states.

Side 2: Greater representation for large states because they have more people.

Issue: How frequently should elections be held?

 ${
m Side}\ 1$ : Having elections too far apart would create long terms and give officials too much power.

Side 2: Having elections too frequently might make officials more concerned about getting elected than about making good decisions.
