

Jamison Elementary School First Grade



Dear Parents and Guardians:

We are happy to welcome you to first grade at Jamison Elementary! We are looking forward to a successful and exciting year with our new first graders!

These are the supplies that you will need to bring with you on the first day of school. **Please remove the packaging from the <u>glue sticks, dry erase markers, pencils,</u> <u>and highlighters</u> and place in a gallon Ziplock bag. The supplies will fit easier in backpacks on the first day and make unpacking easier. We will put some of the supplies in our pencil boxes and store some of the supplies for use later in the year.**

*four 24 count boxes of <u>Crayola</u> crayons
*an 8 or 10 count box of Crayola fine tip markers
*six <u>large</u> glue sticks
*a large box of tissues
*six Expo low-odor dry erase markers
*two highlighters
*twelve yellow <u>Dixon Ticonderoga</u> pencils – sharpened please!
*a sturdy plastic 2 pocket folder
*one container of antibacterial wipes
*a plastic pencil box (Students will use this to hold their personal supplies. Please consider something like the picture.)
* If your last name begins A-L – a box of quart size Ziploc bags
* If your last name begins M-Z – a bottle of hand sanitizer



Please note that it is not necessary to label everything with your child's name. We will fill the pencil boxes and store the additional supplies to replenish as needed.

* Please send in a pair of headphones (<u>no ear buds</u>) to use in library and in the classroom. Be advised that they will be **only for your child's personal use** and will not be used by another child. For sanitary reasons, <u>please send in the headphones in a</u> <u>sealed</u>, <u>plastic Ziploc-type bag and make sure your child's name is clearly labeled</u> in permanent marker. They will be kept in the classroom for your child to use all year.

On the first day of school please have your child bring a traditional backpack. **Please no backpacks with wheels on them.** They are difficult for the first graders to manage.
