Dear Parents,

April is quickly approaching, and your child along with many other students from Bucks County will be participating in a Reading Olympics on **Thursday, April 10<sup>th</sup>** at **Cold Spring Elementary School**. You and other interested family members are welcome to join us. We expect this event to be an enjoyable, rewarding experience for everyone who attends. To ensure a successful evening, we are asking for your cooperation with the guidelines that are listed below:

- This is a heavily attended event. Try to carpool so that traffic jams can be prevented. For the safety of all involved, obey the directions of the security staff.
- The event begins promptly at 6pm. Allow plenty of time for parking and finding the assigned classroom. Classroom assignments will be given later in March.
- Park within clearly identified parking spaces in the school's lot. Our Lady of Guadalupe is next door and has a large parking lot with a path connecting to Cold Spring. Do not drive or park on the grass.
- Food and beverages (except bottled water) are not allowed to be eaten in the classrooms. This rule applies to both student participants and spectators.
- Participants should wear their Reading Olympics' tee shirt, which will be given to the students March 26<sup>th</sup>.
- Student participants should report immediately to the assigned classroom rather than lingering in the hallways. See the back of this page for room assignments.
- Keep in mind that small children will not have the attention span for this academic event and may be happier at home.
- Parents are spectators, not participants. Do not interfere with the questioning process or challenge the judge's decision.
- Student participants and spectators should turn off all cellphones. Video recordings are not permitted.

We look forward to seeing you and your child at the event. Whether or not your child's team accumulates many points, please remember that the students have benefited from a variety of worthwhile reading experiences.
